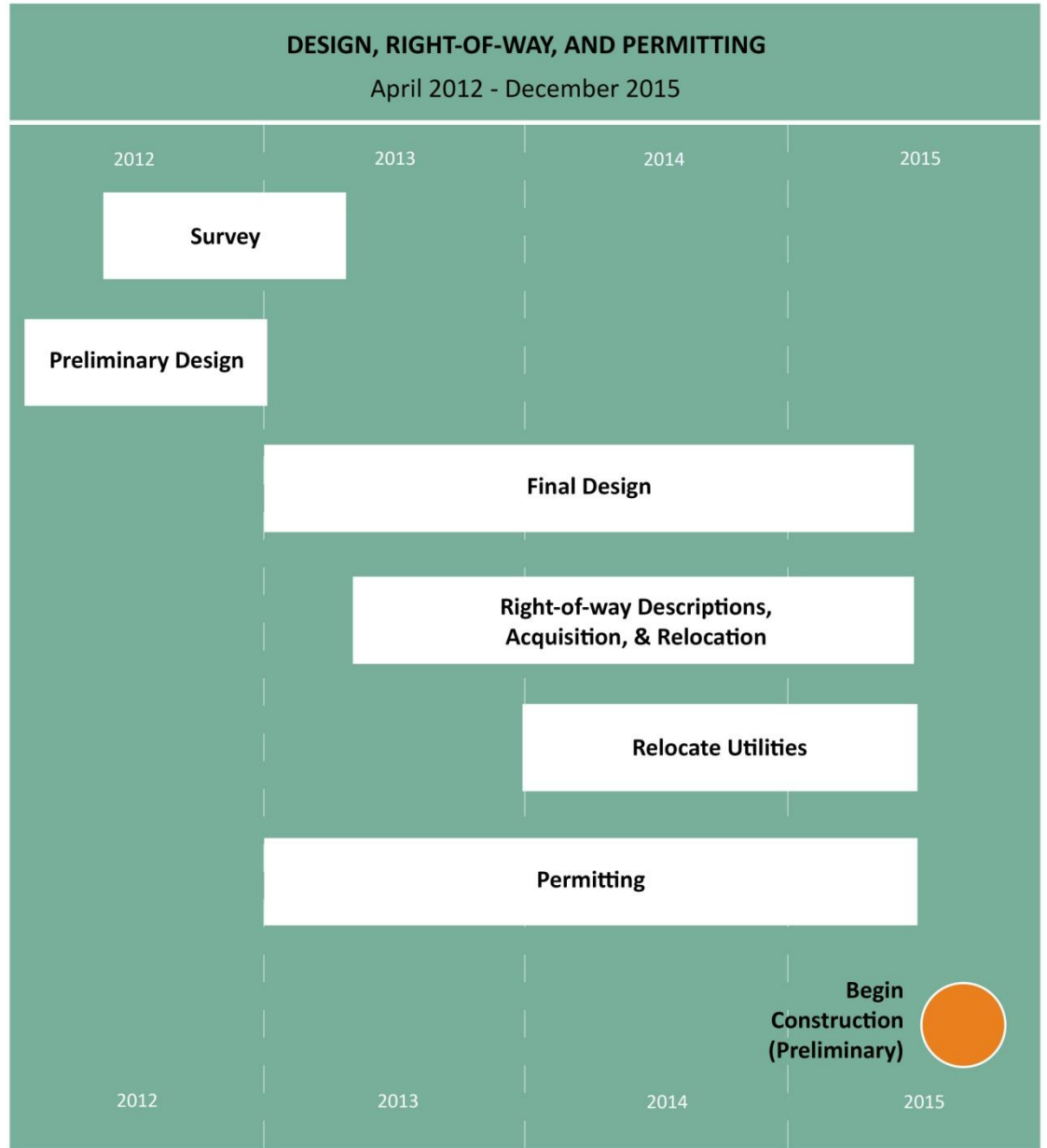
Project status

- Coordinating with Oregon State Parks on affects that the project would have on the state parks

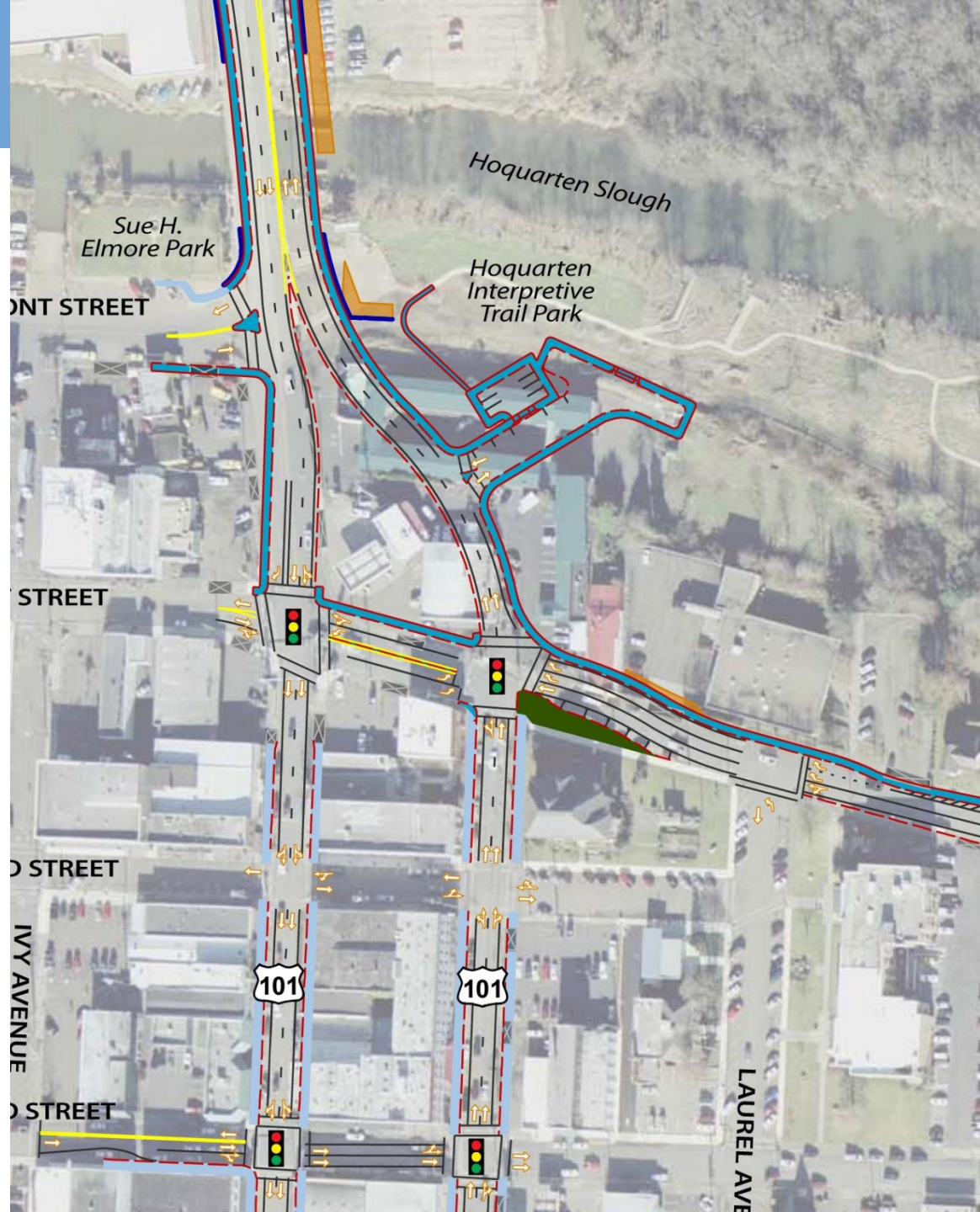
Tillamook US 101/OR 6 Project Timeline

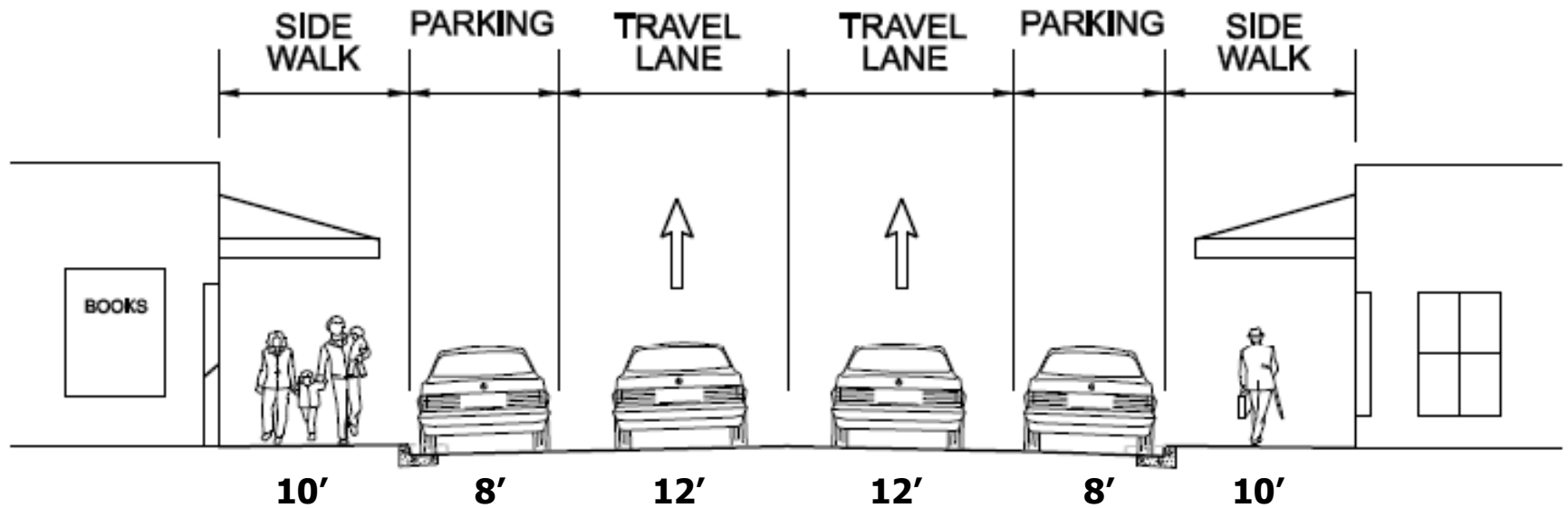

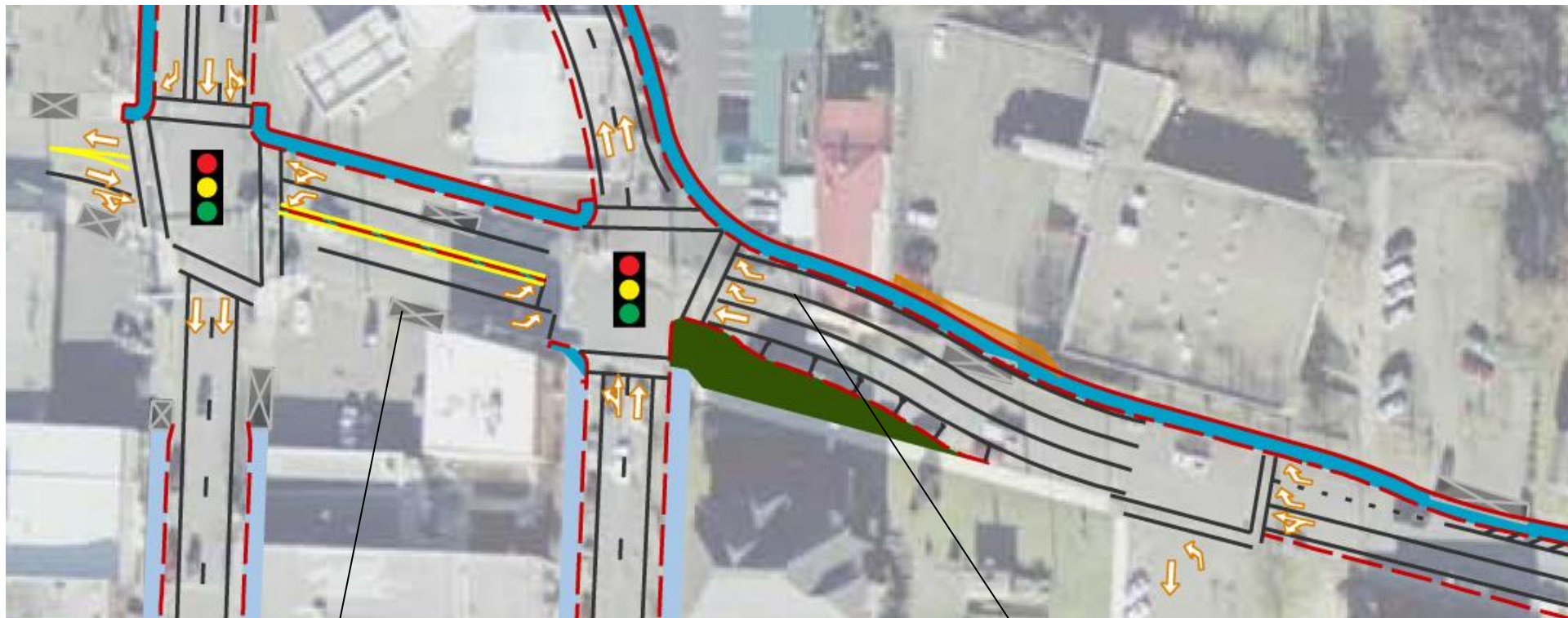

Build Alternative: Main and Pacific Avenues



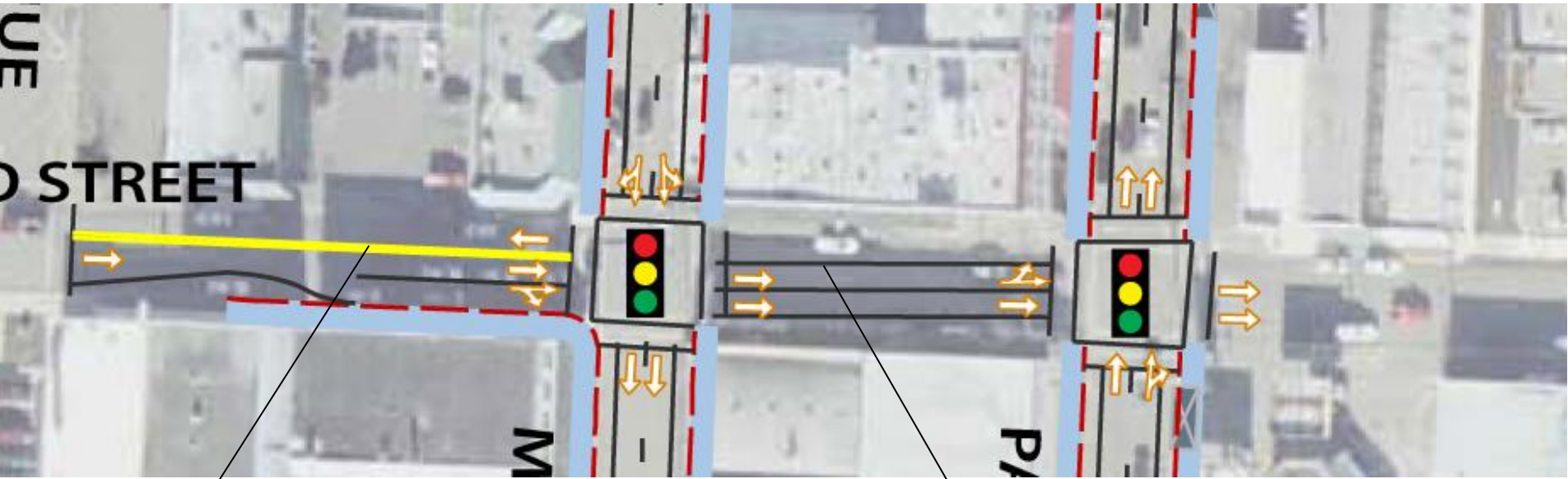
1st Street

3rd Street



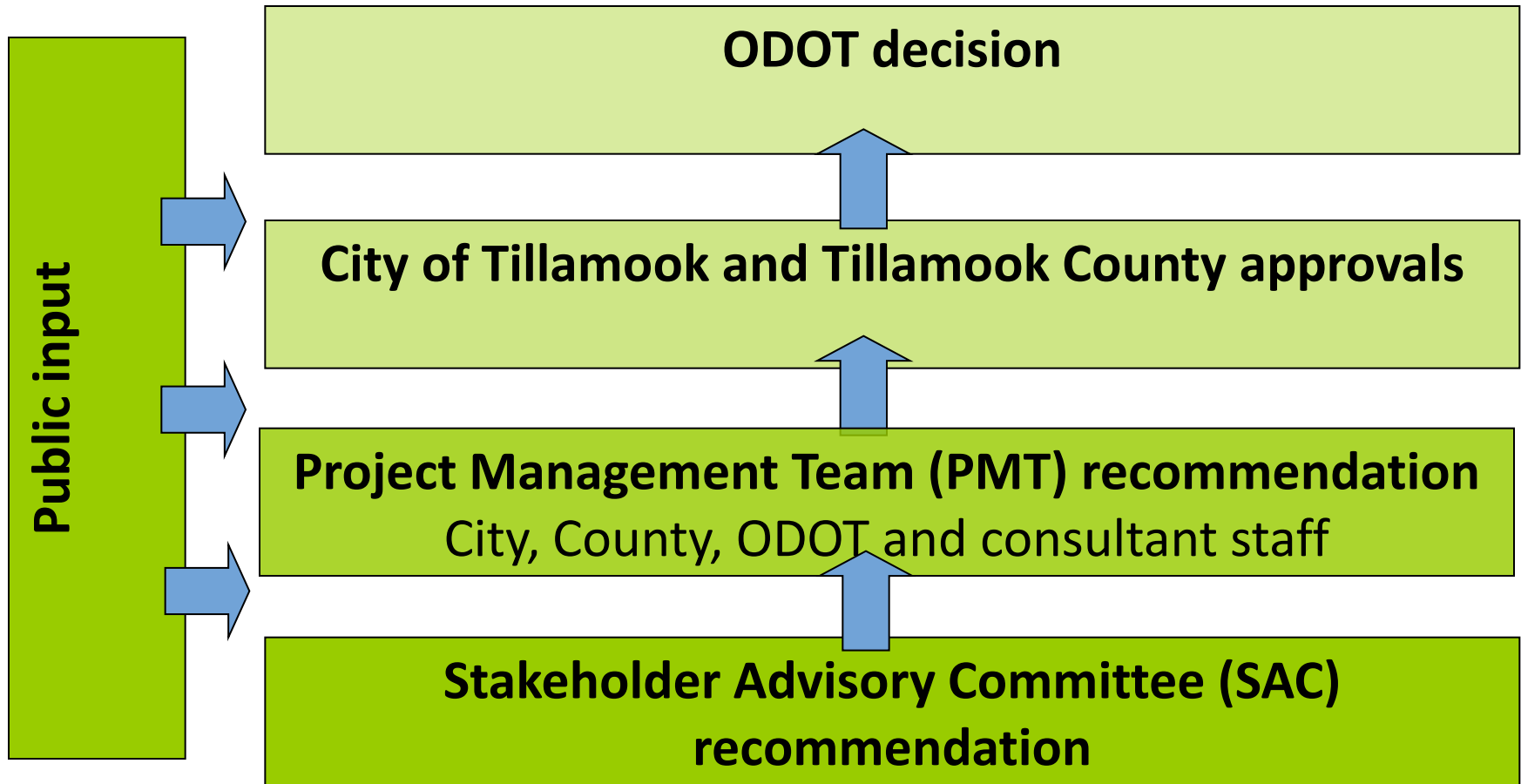
One lane westbound

Environmental Assessment process

- Federally-required process to compare the impacts and benefits of the build alternative to a no-build alternative on the community and natural environment effects
 - Community topics include: noise, historic and cultural resources, parks, land use, traffic, socioeconomics among others
 - Natural environment topics include wetlands, flooding, habitat, air quality among others
- Documentation will be complete in early January 2012
- Publication of EA will be followed by a public comment period and identification of a preferred alternative

 - Newspaper ads
